**Instructions for Announcement Call for Scholarships**  
**The "Clore Scholars Programme"**  
**for 2022-2023 Academic year**

The Clore Scholars Programme issued, an announcement call for PhD students in all following fields:

- natural sciences, including mathematics, physics, chemistry, the life sciences, earth sciences, computer science, agriculture, engineering, and technology
- MD/PhD students

Attached are the "Clore Scholars Programme" guidelines and regulations. Please pay attention to all the regulations and procedures specified. Please be sure to distribute and inform all the relevant parties of these regulations and procedures.

**Applications to the Clore Scholars Programme may not be concurrently submitted to the scholarship programmes of the Adams Foundation, Azrieli Foundation, or the Arian de Rothschild Foundation.**

**Please note: It is not permitted to receive this scholarship in parallel with a scholarship in the name of a donor or in parallel with another external scholarship.**

**Submission Criteria**

**(In addition to the criteria specified in the Clore Scholars Programme announcement call's guidelines and regulations):**

- The Scholarship is intended only for students who have Israeli citizenship.
- Applicants will have an M.Sc. (Or B.Sc. for special track/direct PhD track), who meet the following criteria:
  1. Students who have begun their doctoral studies not more than one and a half years before the deadline date for the submission of the application, i.e. no earlier than 16.7.2020.
  2. Students who have submitted their doctoral proposal, even if this is not yet approved. In this case, the submitting institution is obliged to notify the programme coordinator immediately upon receipt of approval of the doctoral proposal. The awarding of the scholarship is dependent on this approval.  
An academic unit whose applicants will be submitted to the "Clore Scholars Programme" scholarship, undertakes to notify the graduate school immediately upon approval of the research proposal (passing of the candidacy examination) if it was not approved prior to submitting the application.
  3. Students who are eligible for a full scholarship (at least 4 monthly Technion scholarship portions) for the entire 2022-2023 academic year, at least.



**Required documents (in addition to the specified in the "Clore Scholars Programme" announcement call):**

Details and explanations regarding all required documents submission format are in the attached fellowship guidelines and regulations. Please read these instructions carefully and follow them.

**All documents should be submitted in English in the following order:**

**1<sup>st</sup> PDF FILE to include the following in the below order:**

1. **Application form + Candidate's Declaration and Commitment (טופס בקשה והצהרת המועמד)** - as detailed in the "Clore Scholars Programme" regulations and guidelines.
2. **CV (קורות חיים)** - as detailed in the "Clore Scholars Programme" regulations and guidelines.
3. **Recommendation letters (מכתבי המלצה)**: as detailed in the "Clore Scholars Programme" regulations and guidelines.  
**Please Note: since there are many candidates for this scholarship the letters have to be very strong.**
4. **The research proposal summary and the research proposal (הצעת המחקר ותקציר ההצעה)**, as detailed in the "Clore Scholars Programme" regulations and guidelines.

**2<sup>nd</sup> PDF FILE to include the following in the below order:**

It is important that **all documents are official and are signed** by the academic institution.

1. **Average results from previous qualifications (גיליונות ציונים)** - Please note that this means you are requested to submit an **Official, signed PhD transcript**.  
Previous degrees transcripts are not required. The information appears in the PhD transcript. It is therefore important to Make sure that the **final grade point average of previous degrees appears on the PhD transcript**.  
If information is missing from the PhD transcript, please contact the graduate school as soon as possible.

2. **Details of studies (אישורי לימודים)** - as detailed in the "Clore Scholars Programme" regulations and guidelines.  
The Institution approval of candidate's acceptance to Doctoral studies, with research subject noted in English is the **Official, signed PhD transcript as detailed in item #1**

3. **Academic Institution's commitment (התחייבות המוסד האקדמי)**. This will be **processed by the graduate school**.

**Submission Process:**

- The application must be sent as **2 separate PDF files**  
Each file will include bookmarks, containing all the material according to the "Clore Scholars Programme" guidelines and regulations.
- A separate WORD table per applicant, the table should be submitted exactly as detailed in the attached format.



**\*\*Please note\*\*** the "Clare Scholars Programme" indicated that updates to submissions will not be accepted, except in the case of acceptance of publications, and then only with the written approval of the journal stating their intention to publish the article.

**Implementation of scholarships and prizes:**

Upon being awarded an external scholarship, its' implementation is subject to the Technion and the Graduate School guidelines and as detailed in the guidelines and instructions of the Announcement Call as distributed by the Graduate School.

Upon being awarded an external scholarship, its' implementation is subject to Section 9 of the "Scholarship Agreement" and in accordance with the Graduate School's guidelines and regulations, including signing the "scholarship agreement from an external source".

**The Technion may approve the terms of the award/ scholarship and its Implementation and / or condition it on terms according to the Technion sole discretion and in accordance with The Technion guidelines and regulations.**

**Confirmation regarding the submission of applications will be given only towards the submission date of the application.**

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**The application submission timeline within the academic unit will be determined by each unit individually, in accordance with the academic unit's procedures.**

**The application material will be submitted to the Graduate school by the department's Graduate Office.**

The announcement regarding the scholarship recipients will be published by the end of June 2022.
